

Important REIP Program Changes in June 21 Board Order

NOTICE: Per the Board Order dated June 21, 2010, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities has approved changes to the New Jersey Clean Energy Program specifically to the *Renewable Energy Incentive Program* (REIP). [Lower rebate levels and new eligibility requirements](#) take effect with REIP Solar Funding Cycle 3. An updated REIP Solar Technical Worksheet with new rebate levels and other program changes will soon be available.

Funding Cycle 3 opens up for new applications on September 1, 2010. All application packets received in Funding Cycle 3 must include the new REIP Solar Technical Worksheet dated June 2010.

The following incentives are available for REIP applications effective with Funding Cycle 3, which starts September 1, 2010
